








Ink & pigments

Conventional metallic pigments




- White / silver reflected light from the aluminum particles is dominant
- Reflection of the loose color pigments produce an uneven color image (deep-lying particles reflect weakly, highlying particles strongly)
- The metallic effect only appears through the aluminum particles



Ink & pigments

Paint-It 010/011 Metallic pigments



- Reflected light is always colored because the light goes through the color pigments
- Less unsteady reflections, as there are no individually distributed color pigments in the solvent
- Color pigments are therefore metallic in appearance
